Swimlane Certified SOAR Administrator (SCSA)

Who: A Swimlane Certified SOAR Administrator (SCSA) can implement SOAR use cases and manage the Swimlane platform.

Swimlane Certified SOAR Developer (SCSD)

What: Instructor-led training with hands-on practicals that teach students how to develop and deploy custom content, to include integrations and widgets. To be eligible for the developer certification, individuals must have completed the SCSA certification previously.
